## New Library Catalog!

We have a new library catalog that will bring new features to help all our patrons. This is available as a direct link on our website – look on the right hand side.

Here are some new things to enjoy – continuing emails on what you have checked out and when the items are due back, notification via email when items that you placed on reserve are ready to be picked up, and a paper receipt (if requested) when you check materials out.

In addition, you can sign into your own account to check your history of what you’ve checked out, renew items, and place items on reserve. If you don’t know your card number, please just ask! Your password is the telephone number that we have on file for you (603 area code not needed).

## Start Downloading Books & Audios Now

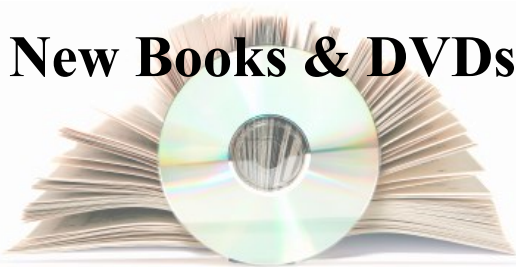

Your password is your telephone number without an area code. It needs to be the same telephone number that we have on file for you. Please contact us if you have any problems or need help.

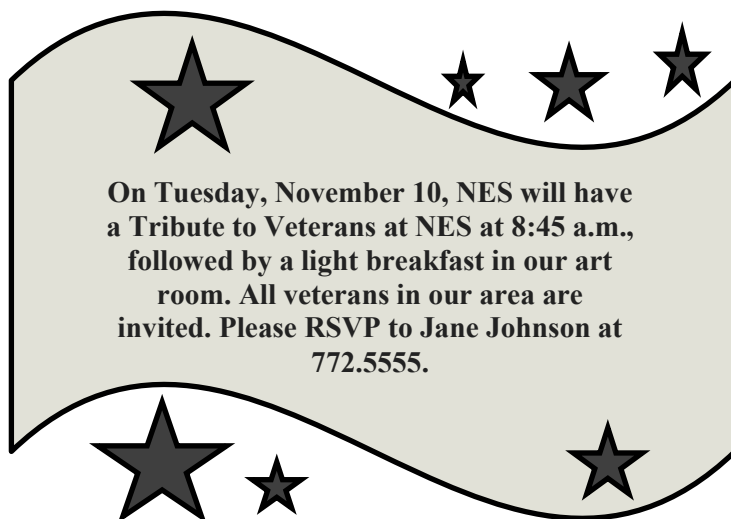
March 7, 2016 will be the first Garden Club meeting in next year.
